Attend two meetings

No dues or fees required!

Cornerstone Chess Club's policy of allowing a free trial membership continues. As long as space and volunteer help allows, children may attend two club meetings before committing to formally join our group. Our meetings are a mix of group instruction and one-on-one play. The club meets on Thursdays; check-in is in the area in front of the Chapel right after school, and the children will be placed in groups based on skill-level from there.

Pick-up is in their assigned rooms or the Chapel, and must be made not later than 4:45. Children not picked up by that time will be taken to Extended Care. Parents or other pre-authorized representatives must come in to pick up their child(ren), as they may not leave their rooms without their parent present. Additionally, children that will not follow instructions, repeatedly disrupt the teachings, or whom 'don't want to play chess' may also be taken to Extended Care, at their parents' expense.

We request that a cell phone or other contact number for parents is sent with your child, in case there are issues where we may need your assistance. We additionally ask that you **stop by the check-in area to pick up any informational flyers**, at the meetings' end. Regular club dues are \$65 for the school year, \$40 for additional family members after the first, but no child will be excluded solely due to the inability to pay. For those who would like to have a Chess Magnet School membership, it will be an additional \$15/child for the school year.

While tournament attendance is not required of members, there will be numerous opportunities throughout the year to participate, culminating in the Washington state scholastic chess championships and the USCF National tournaments!

Membership is open for grades Kindergarten and up; Pre-K (with a parent's attendance and pre-approval) is possible. Volunteer positions are available Thursdays from 2:30 until 4:45 – as well as shorter shifts; drop-in help is always welcomed, too, chess experience or not!
